## Value Stream Mapping Workshop

### October 16, 2009

#### Presentation Summary

While the management in your company may not be ready to embrace the whole Lean Enterprise philosophy, there are several tools you can begin using right away that may bring significant improvement to your business, and one of those tools is Value Stream Mapping. This four hour (half-day) workshop will explain what is meant by Value, and define what a Value Stream is. Finally the workshop will show participants how to identify and create the Action Plan necessary to implement the changes identified in the Value Stream Map.
